



Jezzine is one of the 3 districts of the South Lebanon Governorate, and is composed of 38 villages




It is located approximately 30 min away from the Port of Saida, Lebanon's 3rd biggest Sea port

MAP OF TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE | 2005




Jezzine is the smallest districts of the South Governorate, with an area of 241 km², accounting for 26% of the Governorate's total size...

AREA SIZE OF DISTRICTS IN SOUTH LEBANON GOVERNORATE | 2016




DISTRIBUTION OF SOUTH LEBANON AREA SIZE BY DISTRICT | 2016




... and is the least populated district with around 25,000 inhabitants, accounting for 4% of the South population

POPULATION OF DISTRICTS IN SOUTH LEBANON GOVERNORATE | 2016




DISTRIBUTION OF SOUTH LEBANON POPULATION BY DISTRICT | 2016






There are 2 vocational schools in Jezzine, and students usually attend one of Saida's 8 universities...

NUMBER OF HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTES IN SAIDA AND JEZZINE | 2016




DISTRIBUTION OF VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS & UNIVERSITIES IN THE JEZZINE DISTRICT | 2016




...however, the presence of 11 public schools, of which 5 are located in Jezzine city maintains a high literacy rate in the district, higher than the Lebanese average




Most of the Jezzine territory is covered in natural areas, the highest portion compared to South Lebanon Districts...



... and is situated between 300 to 1600 meters above sea level ensuring mild climate conditions and different soil types




The 3 rivers spanning its area render the agriculture sector a primary source of activity for the Jezzine inhabitants...




... with different agricultural activities and a variety of agricultural produces coming from Jezzine




Initiatives have been put in place to expand agricultural activities, but there's room for increased investment along the Agriculture and Agrofood value chain



Tourism is also an important economic driver of the region which offers a regional park and important summer health locations...




...in addition to the highest concentration of remarkable landscapes, including natural sites, cascades, grottos, and a picturesque village



Investment have taken place in 7 hotels mostly located in Azour and Jezzine villages...




DISTRIBUTION OF HOTELS PER VILLAGE IN JEZZINE % | 2016






... and employing 103 people, with around 80% of them working in Azour and Bkassine villages

NUMBER OF HOTEL EMPLOYEES PER VILLAGE IN JEZZINE | 2016




DISTRIBUTION OF HOTEL EMPLOYEES PER VILLAGE IN JEZZINE % 2016





Individual activity is mostly concentrated in non-mineral and metal subsectors...





DISTRIBUTION OF **NON MINERAL MINING COMPANIES** BY ACTIVITY % | 2016




DISTRIBUTION OF **METAL COMPANIES** BY ACTIVITY % | 2016






The majority of the labor force in Jezzine is engaged in non-mineral mining with some in food and beverage




Jezzine city is the center of the industrial activities of the district, with around 40% of industrial companies and around 40% of total industrial workforce






DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYEES BY CITY IN JEZZINE DISTRICT % | 2016





MAIN EXPORT DESTINATIONS OF INDUSTRIAL COMPANIES % | 2016





OPPORTU-NITIES

- The Agriculture sector generates around 4.7% of Lebanon's GDP
- In 2014/2015, world production of pine nuts achieved 39,950 MT, 86% up from 2004
- The Agro Food sector is the largest industrial sector in Lebanon accounting for 18% of total industrial enterprises
- Total contribution of the tourism sector to GDP was 25.1% in 2013, the highest rate in the region
- The industrial sector accounts for 7.5% of national output and employs 25% of the labor force

The diversification of the Jezzine district results in a number of investment opportunities in key sectors

AGRICULTURE • Investment opportunities in pine nut production

AGRO-FOOD

- Increased opportunities for olive oil and wine production due to the region's diverse topography, climate and fertile soil
- Investment opportunities in Goat Dairy products

TOURISM

• Investment opportunities in eco-tourism



The largest pine forest in the MENA, Bkassine, provides opportunities for large scale production of pine nuts. There is currently only 1 processing/packaging facility in Jezzine




Olive oil is amongst the most prominent Lebanese agro-industrial products with a high export potential, however there is only 1 olive oil producer in the region

TOP DESTINATIONS OF LEBANESE OLIVE OIL EXPORTS % | 2015







Goat breeding is more extended than cow breeding in Jezzine and has a high potential to satisfy the large local demand for dairy products










There is only 1 winery in Jezzine, but due to the importance of Jezzine as the only wine region in South Lebanon, other wineries have established vineyards in the area
